



## **Here's just a few ways how you and/or your group can be hands on:**

### **Administrative and Computer Support**

On weekdays, support our administrative offices by answering phones, helping with mail, filing and other light office work. We are also seeking people capable of basic computer repair.

### **Literacy Partners**

Do you like to read? Help one of our LifeBuilders recovery students learn or improve their reading skills.

### **Mentors and Tutors**

In the advanced phases of our LifeBuilders recovery program, our students become eligible to begin work with a mentor. Mentors encourage and promote a healthy lifestyle through the power of Jesus Christ. Additionally, students working on their GED often need help with academic skills. Tutoring sessions can be scheduled for most days and some evenings.

### **Life Skills Instructors**

Help a group of LifeBuilders recovery students learn more about a particular life skill such as anger management, language or Internet usage.

### **Thrift Store and Auto Center**

The CRM Thrift Store has an ongoing need for individuals (and groups) to perform a variety of maintenance and display tasks. We ask that you be at least 16 years of age. Shade-tree mechanic? Our Auto Center needs your volunteer help to fix up donated cars for resale.

### **Job Coach**

Provide support services for students who are transitioning from the LifeBuilders residential program to independent living. As a job coach, you promote a partnership between CRM students who are seeking employment and local businesses and act as an encourager and a hand-holder as our students transition back into the workforce

### **Professional Services**

There are many areas at CRM that can benefit from your professional knowledge. If you'd like to share your expertise in your career field and can commit to two hours a week, we'd love to welcome you as a professional consultant. We especially need volunteer doctors and dentists and related personnel to help in our onsite medical and dental clinics.



### **Ground Maintenance, Landscaping, Cleaning and Painting**
